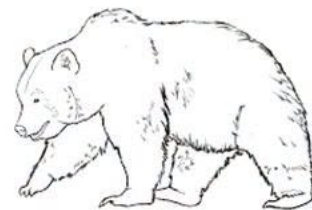

- St. Theresa Cemetery, 2 miles east of Rosssburn
- Christ The King Cemetery, east side of Rossmann Lake
- St. Catherine Cemetery, south side of Oakburn
- St. John Cantius Cemetery, Oakburn Farms at Tokaryk Lake

Since our ancestors arrived in the community these cemeteries have been the sacred resting places of our family members, other loved ones, veterans and pioneers.

The cemetery board is currently undertaking the essential task of restoring, repairing, replacing and ensuring proper identification of the grave markers in these cemeteries to protect and preserve the dignity of our loved ones and the heritage of our community.

- Many graves belong to veterans, early settlers, family members and other loved ones.
 - To continue the legacy for future generations
- It is important to maintain a peaceful well-kept place for family visitation.

**RESIDENTS ASKED TO
IMMEDIATELY REDUCE WATER USE**

Due to the significant rainfall, Rosssburn's wastewater system has reached capacity. Although the lift station and pumps are operating as designed, they cannot keep up with the volume of water entering the system.

Residents are being asked to immediately reduce water use until further notice. Your cooperation is critical in helping reduce the strain on the wastewater system and minimizing the risk of sewer backups.

Please help by:

- Postponing laundry and other water-intensive activities
- Delaying the use of dishwashers
- Limiting unnecessary use of showers, sinks, and toilets
- Ensuring sump pumps discharge directly outdoors and are not connected to the sanitary sewer system

The situation is being closely monitored as this weather event continues. We appreciate everyone's immediate cooperation. Further updates will be provided as conditions change.

HIGH WATER ADVISORY**

Due to the heavy rainfall, water levels are rising and there are multiple culvert and road wash outs.

Please be aware that barricades may not yet be in place at all affected locations.

- If you come across a barricade, please respect it and do not drive through or around it.
- Do not drive through water on roads. You may not know how deep it is or what damage is underneath.
- IF A ROAD IS CLOSED, DO NOT TRAVEL ON IT.
- Moving or removing barricades is illegal and puts you and others at risk.
- DO NOT TRAVEL ROADS OR LEAVE YOUR HOME UNLESS IT IS SAFE TO DO SO.

Please use caution if you must travel and watch for changing road conditions and rising water levels.
