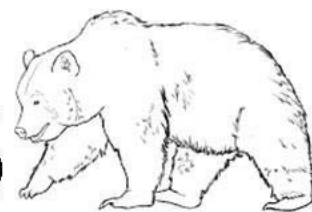

YARDWASTE PICK-UP

Pick-up Guidelines:



50 lb limit for bags, branches and tree limbs

- Bag grass clippings & leaves in clear bags
- Ensure tree branches are a manageable size - length and weight
- Plastic flowerpots are NOT yard waste, place in regular garbage - they are not recyclable
- Yard waste can be piled at back lane (if accessible)
- Place yard waste at curb/back lane before 9:00AM

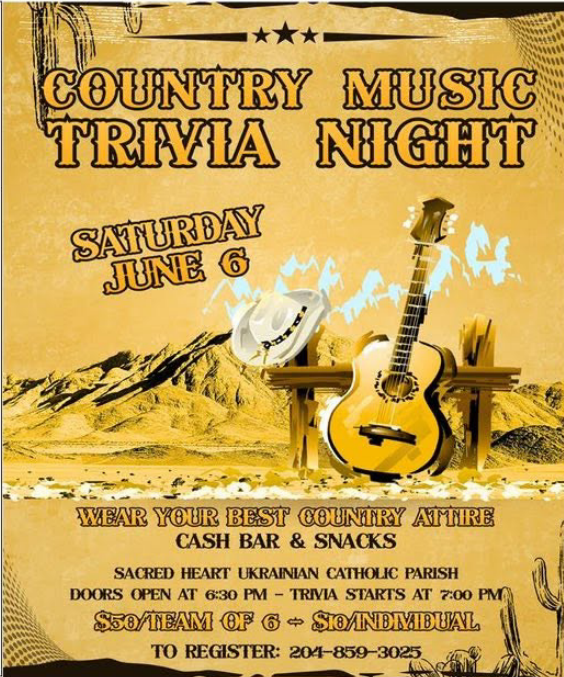
